Security is No Security if it is not Techno Legal Security.

M/s XYZ IT Services is a BPO Company which develops software processes Health and Financial Information. It has installed sophisticated Firewall and IDS systems to secure data. It maintains an effective DRP and BCP.

But a hacker gains access to the company's systems, deletes critical data and publishes some of the critical personal information of the clients whose data was being processed on a website.

CEO summons the IS Manager to seek a remedy. IS Manager says "I will restore the data within the next few minutes"... And does so... Every one seems satisfied.

....Until after a few days, Company receives a notice from its principal seeking damages for the data loss and indemnification against claims made by its clients.

CEO again summons the IS Manager...He replies.. "I can only protect the data... I don't know how to protect the data owner".

CEO wonders.....What use is it to call our systems secure if it cannot protect the company which owns the system?...

Next day.. CEO meets his friend who works as IS Manager in another company and throws the question of how he would have handled the same situation.

He says,..."We have conducted a CyLawCom audit and enabled ourselves with DLP and OLR". Our security covers not only the information but also the Information owner".

How Do you prepare for DLP-OLR?

To be capable of defending a damage suit on one self and to launch a damage suit on the offender who caused the security breach, it is necessary that the victim company meet the requirements prescribed by various legislations that affect its working.

This compliance of law applicable to those who work in Cyber Space is Cyber Law Compliance. CyLawCom audit, implementation and certification is a process where by Cyber Law risks are identified, mitigated and certified.

In the context of Companies working in India, ITA-2000 compliance (Compliance measures mandated under Information Technology Act 2000) becomes the key requirement. For a BPO, compliance of Data Protection Act, HIPAA or GLBA. are also relevant. Additionally, SOX, SAS 70 and Clause 49 compliance are relevant based on the listing status of the company. Insurance companies need to look at Insurance regulations and AML regulations. Banks should satisfy Basel II and AML regulations.

Some of these are also captured in the industry security standards such PCI data security standard and ISO 27001 are also important compliance .

Compliance of all these regulations along with the DRP-BCP oriented Technical Security measures would be required for a Company to fulfill the DLP-OLR requirements.
